Booking Your Fundraiser

- Please book well in advance.
- Jimmy Mac's Pub holds fundraisers Saturday through Thursdays. We will not book a fundraiser on a date that may conflict with Monday Night Football or Canucks games.
- A \$150 deposit is needed within two weeks of booking your event. This deposit will be used towards your bill on your event night. If you cancel less than two weeks prior to the date of your event, the deposit is non-refundable.
- The Pub can accommodate up to 100 guests.
- We suggest guests arrive an hour before dinner is served. This gives them time to look at silent auction items and mingle before sitting down for food.

Burger and Beer (\$7.50/person) (gratuity not included)

All fundraiser guests will receive a cheeseburger, fries and a pint of house draft, juice, pop, coffee or tea. All burgers have cheese, meat, mayo, lettuce, tomato and onion on the bun. We cannot do any modifications (eg. No mayo, no tomato, no soup/salad instead of fries...). Guests wanting different food may order from the regular menu.

(a maximum of three veggie burgers may replace cheeseburgers if told a number at least two weeks in advance.)

Tickets

Tickets must be approved by Elissa before sales start.

We suggest you sell tickets for \$15. This enables a group of 100 to make \$750 for their organization.

Most groups make their tickets on regular paper. If you're trying to raise money, there's no point spending a lot on getting tickets printed.

THREE PARTS OF A TICKET:

Left side: “good for one pint of house draught, coffee, tea, pop or juice.”

Center: event name, date, arrival time, eating time, Jimmy Mac’s Pub 19935 96 Ave, Langley, (some people number the center part of the ticket for door prizes—this will be the only portion that the customer gets to keep because the server will collect the left and the right portions to order the food/drink)

Right side: “good for one fundraiser cheeseburger and fries” (no substitutions)

Money Raising Ideas

Silent Auction

Jimmy Mac’s can provide tables for your silent auction items. We suggest you obtain prizes through local community businesses, organizations etc.

50/50 Draw

Some groups hold 50/50 draws to raise extra money – a gaming license is required to have one of these draws. Please see below for instructions on how to obtain one of these licenses.

GAMING LICENCE PROCEDURES FOR FUNDRAISERS FOR 50/50 DRAWS

-go on the web www.pssg.gov.bc.ca/gaming

-on the left side, click on licenses (gaming event)

-on the left side, click on Class B License (under 20,000)

-on the left side, click on Online Application (or print application—it takes longer)

-scroll down to Start Online Application

-it is \$25 non-refundable

-it takes three business days to process online applications and up to a week or longer for applications sent through the mail
